Independent auditor's report

To the Financial agent of Renee Merrifield and the Chief Electoral Office of British Columbia,

Qualified Opinion

We have audited the election financing report ("the financial report") of Renee Merrifield ("the Candidate") for the election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Kelowna-Mission.

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the *Basis for Qualified* Opinion section of our report, the accompanying election financial report of Renee Merrifield for the British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Kelowna-Mission is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act (British Columbia).

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, verification of these amounts was limited to the amounts recorded in the election campaign records of the Candidate. Therefore, we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to Contribution Revenue, Other Revenue and Other Expenses in the financial report.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards as required by Section 214 of the Election Act (British Columbia). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report* section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial report in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter - Restriction on Use

The financial report is prepared to assist the Candidate to meet the financial reporting requirements of Part 10 and Section 214 of the Election Act (British Columbia). As a result, the statement may not be suitable for another purpose. Our report is intended solely for the Candidate, Renee Merrifield, the financial agent and the office of the Chief Electoral Officer and should not be used by parties other than the Candidate, Renee Merrifield, the financial agent and the office of the Chief Electoral Officer. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of the Financial Agent for the Election Financial Report

Management is responsible for the preparation of this financial report in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act (British Columbia), and for such internal control as The financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Election Financial Report

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue and auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial report.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit.

We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to
 fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain
 audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of
 not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting
 from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations,
 or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit
 procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing
 an opinion on the effectiveness of the Candidate's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the financial agent.

We communicate with the financial agent of Renee Merrifield, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
