

Qualified Opinion

I have audited the accompanying financial report of Laura Lynn relating to British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Abbotsford South.

In my opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion section of my report, the accompanying financial report of Laura Lynn for the British Columbia interest for the election held on October 24, 2020 is prepared, in all materials respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act (British Columbia).

Basis for qualified opinion

I draw attention to **Note 1** to the report which describe the summary of contraventions of the election Act (British Columbia) and key finding on the report.

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the Laura Lynn's records and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the financial report.

I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards as required by Section 214 of the Election Act (British Columbia). My responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report* section of my report. I am independent of Laura Lynn in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to my audit of the financial report in Canada, and I have fulfilled my other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter – Restriction on Use

This financial report is prepared to assist Laura Lynn to comply with the financial reporting provisions of the Election Act (British Columbia) referred to above. As a result, the financial report may not be suitable for another purpose. My opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of the Financial Agent for the Financial Report

The financial agent is responsible for the preparation of the financial report in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act (British Columbia) and for such internal control as the financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of a financial report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report

My objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and is to issue an auditor's report that includes my opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this financial report.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, I exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. I also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial report, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Laura Lynn's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the financial agent.

I communicate with the financial agent of Laura Lynn regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that I identify during my audit.
