In our opinion, except for the effects of the matters described in *Basis for Qualified Opinion* section of the report, the accompanying election financing report of Toni Boot for the British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Penticton is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act (British Columbia).

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the election campaign records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the election financing report.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards as required by Section 214 of the *Election Act* (British Columbia). Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Election Financing Report*. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Emphasis of Matter – Restriction on Use

This election financing report is prepared to assist Toni Boot to comply with the financial reporting provisions of the Election Act (British Columbia) referred to above. As a result, the election financing report may not be suitable for another purpose. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

Responsibilities of the Financial Agent for the Election Financing Report
