INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To John Sutherland, financial agent for Sandra Stoddart-Hansen

Qualified opinion

We have audited the accompanying Candidate's election financing report (the "Report") for the candidacy of Sandra Stoddart-Hansen, a candidate at the British Columbia 2020 election of held on the day of October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Powell River – Sunshine Coast.

This Report has been prepared by the official agent for the Candidate based on the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the *Election Act*.

In our opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the election financing report of Sandra Stoddart-Hansen for the British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of Powell River-Sunshine Coast is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the *Election Act*.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the election campaign records and we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the election financing report.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Report section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Report in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified opinion.

Basis of Accounting

The election financing report is prepared to assist the candidate to comply with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Elections Act. As a result, the election financing report may not be suitable for another purpose.

Financial Agent's Responsibility for the Election Financing Report

The financial agent is responsible for the preparation of the election financing report in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the *Election Act*, and for such internal control as the financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of election financing reports that are free from material misstatement, whether due to error or fraud.

Those charged with governance are responsible for overseeing the Candidate's financial reporting process.



Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Report. As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Report, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the campaign's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the official agent.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
