INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To David Brett, financial agent for Lorraine Brett

I have audited the accompanying election financing report of Lorraine Brett relating to the British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of New Westminster. The election financing report has been prepared by the financial agent for Lorraine Brett based on the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act.

Financial agent's responsibility for the election financing report

The financial agent is responsible for the preparation of the election financing report in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act, and for such internal control as the financial agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of election financing reports that are free from material misstatement, whether due to error or fraud.

Auditor's responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on the election financing report based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards as required by Section 214 of the Election Act (British Columbia). Those standards require that I comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the election financing report is free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the election financing report. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of risks of material misstatement of the election financing report, whether due to error or fraud. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the financial agent's preparation of the election financing report in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the candidate's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and reasonableness of accounting



estimates made by the financial agent, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the election financing report.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my qualified audit opinion.

Basis for Qualified Opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, my verification of these transactions was limited to the amounts recorded in the election campaign records and I was not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the election financing report.

Qualified Opinion

In my opinion, except for the effects of the matter described in the Basis for Qualified Opinion paragraph, the election financing report of Lorraine Brett for the British Columbia election held on October 24, 2020 in the electoral district of New Westminster is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act.

Basis of Accounting

The election financing report is prepared to assist Lorraine Brett to comply with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10 of the Election Act. As a result, the election financing report may not be suitable for another purpose.
