

# Independent auditor's report

To Kevin Tang, Financial Agent for

## Qualified opinion

We have audited the Election Financing Report of **Elenore Sturko** [the "Candidate"] for the Surrey South by-election held on September 10, 2022, which includes the Statement of Election Income and Expenses; Summary of Expenses; Summary of Election Advertising Expenses by Class; Transfers Received and Given; Summary of Election Expense Reimbursement Claim; and Details of Election Expense Reimbursement Claim forms [together the "Election Financing Report"].

In our opinion, except for the possible effects of the matter described in the *Basis for qualified opinion* section of our report, the accompanying Election Financing Report is prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with the financial reporting provisions of Part 10, Division 6, Sections 209 and 213 of the *Election Act* (British Columbia).

## Basis for qualified opinion

Due to the nature of the transactions inherent in any election campaign, the completeness of contributions and other revenue and expenses is not susceptible to satisfactory audit verification. Accordingly, our verification of election income and election expenses and other expenses was limited to the amounts recorded in Candidate's by-election campaign records. Therefore, we were not able to determine whether any adjustments might be necessary to the Election Financing Report.

We conducted our audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the *Auditor's responsibilities for the audit of the Election Financing Report* section of our report. We are independent of the Candidate in accordance with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of the Election Financing Report in Canada, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our qualified audit opinion.

## Emphasis of matter – basis of accounting and restriction on use

We draw attention to note 1 to the Election Financing Report, which describes the basis of accounting. The Election Financing Report is prepared to assist the Candidate and its Financial Agent to meet the requirements of Part 10, Division 6, Sections 209 and 213 of the *Election Act* (British Columbia). As a result, the Election Financing Report may not be suitable for another purpose.

Our report is intended solely for the Candidate, its Financial Agent, and the British Columbia Chief Electoral Officer and should not be used by parties other than the Candidate, its Financial Agent, and the British Columbia Chief Electoral Officer. Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

## Responsibilities of the Financial Agent for the Election Financing Report

The Financial Agent is responsible for the preparation of the Election Financing Report in accordance with the financial reporting provisions specified in Part 10, Division 6, Sections 209 and 213 of the *Election Act* (British Columbia); this includes determining that the applicable financial reporting framework is acceptable for the preparation of the Election Financing Report in the circumstances, and for such internal control as the Financial Agent determines is necessary to enable the preparation of the Election Financing Report that is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.



### **Auditor's responsibilities for the audit of the Election Financing Report**

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Election Financing Report as a whole is free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of this Election Financing Report.

As part of an audit in accordance with Canadian generally accepted auditing standards, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the Election Financing Report, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Candidate's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the Financial Agent.

We communicate with the Financial Agent of the Candidate regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.
